### **CLUB RULES**

(Effective from May 2003)

1. The Club to be known as the Harrow Camera Club.
2. Its objects are to enable photographic workers in Harrow and district to meet at frequent intervals for the interchange of ideas and experience, with lectures and discussions on photographic work.
3. Membership to be open to anyone interested in photography.
4. Meetings to be held weekly throughout the year.
5. An Exhibition of Photographic Work to be held annually.
6. Photographic outings to be arranged as required.
7. An Annual General Meeting to be held, at which annual subscriptions shall be determined for the current subscription year. A General Meeting may be called at any time by not less than 6 members, on notice being given to the Committee. Two weeks notice must be given to all members.
8. Any member whose subscription is unpaid three months after the Annual General Meeting is liable to forfeit membership without notice.
9. The business of the Club to be conducted by a Committee elected each year (by ballot if necessary) and announced at the Annual General Meeting, and comprising the Officers - Chairman, Vice Chairman, Treasurer, Secretary; and Members - Immediate Past Chairman, Competitions Secretary, Exhibition Secretary, Information Secretary, Programme Secretary, Social Secretary, and two other members. A quorum to be five. No Chairman shall hold that office for more than two years consecutively.
10. The Committee have power to appoint an Assistant for any purpose; also to co-opt additional members if necessary.
11. Cheques on the Club's bank account to be signed by any two of the Officers.
12. The Club Rules may not at any time be altered or varied except with the sanction of three-fourths of the members present at a General Meeting, subject to two weeks notice of the proposal to alter or vary the Club Rules.
