Digital File Specification for External Competitions Advice to Guest Clubs

Application:

This specification applies to CACC Rosebowl and to North West London Federation matches.

General Requirements:

CACC and NWFed general media requirements:

- Images must be in RGB mode (even for monochrome images), and in the sRGB colour space.
- The image area must not identify the author or Club
- The image file type must be 'jpg' (not 'jpeg', 'tif' or 'tiff'). Saving at maximum jpg quality is recommended.
- Images should be sent so that they are received FOURTEEN days before the event.

Local Requirements:

Harrow CC publishes the following in accordance with CACC requirements, and the same is also published in the NWFed handbook:

The projection size is 1024 x 768 pixels.

[Relative to this size, smaller images will be projected as submitted, while larger images may suffer a loss of quality when resized during projection.]

The file name format is Seq TITLE by Author Clubcode
where Seq is a TWO digit number (01-15) as the Club's required projection order;
 TITLE is all in upper case, and may contain blanks, hyphens etc;
 by is typed as shown;
 Author is capitalised as required, and may contain blanks, hyphens etc;
 Clubcode is the code published by CACC;
 and each of the above items is separated by one blank.

Example: 01 SEAL 96 by John Smith HAR

All the files for the event should be placed in a single folder, and the folder burnt to a CD-R disk (not CD-RW and not any type of DVD) sent by post.

Given postal problems, the folder may be compressed to a zip file, and may be sent electronically using the procedures for either www.sizeablesend.com or www.yousendit.com as recommended and published by NWFed.

The receiving officer for Harrow CC is as published in the CACC Yearbook and in the NWFed Handbook respectively.
